### Measure Description

Women 16-24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one Chlamydia test during the measurement year.

### Using Correct Billing Codes

#### Codes to identify Chlamydia Screening

Description	CPT Code
Chlamydia Screening	87110, 87270, 87320, 87490-87492, 87810

*\* ICD-10 -CM codes are to be used on or after 10/1/2015.*

### How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Perform Chlamydia screening every year on every 16-24-year old female identified as sexually active (use any visit opportunity).
- Add Chlamydia screening as a standard lab for women 16-24 years old. Use adolescent well-care exams and well woman exams for this purpose.
- Ensure that you have an opportunity to speak with your adolescent female patient without her parents present.
- Remember that Chlamydia screening can be performed through a urine test. Offer this option for your patients.
