

HEDIS® Provider Guide:

Measure Description

Children 13 years of age who received the following vaccines on or before their 13th birthday:

- **1 Meningococcal Vaccine**
(must be completed on or between the 11th and 13th birthdays)
- **1 Tdap**
(must be completed on or between the 11th and 13th birthdays)
- **3 Doses of Human Papillomavirus Vaccine Or
2 Doses of Human Papillomavirus Vaccine**
(There must be at least 146 days between the first and second dose of the HPV vaccine).
(entire series completed between the 9th and 13th birthdays)

Codes to Identify Adolescent Immunizations

Description	CPT Codes
Meningococcal	90733, 90734
Tdap	90715
Human Papillomavirus (HPV)	90649, 90650, 90651

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Use the California State Immunization Registry (CAIR) to register immunizations: www.cair.com
- Review missing vaccines with parents.
- Recommend immunizations to parents. Parents are more likely to agree with vaccinations when supported by the provider. Address misconceptions about vaccinations.
- Train office staff to prep the chart in advance of the visit and identify overdue immunizations.
- Make every office visit count. Take advantage of sick visits for catching up on needed vaccines.
- Have a system for patient reminders.
- Some vaccines may have been given before the patients were CHOC Health Alliance members. Transcribe these vaccinations into CAIR even if your office did not provide the vaccine.
