

HEDIS® Provider Guide:

Measure Description

The percentage of members 12 months - 19 years of age who had a visit with a Primary Care Provider.

4 Categories:

- **12-24 months**, a visit with PCP during the current year
- **25 months – 6 years**, a visit with PCP during the current year
- **7-11 years**, a visit with a PCP during the current year or the year prior
- **12-19 years**, a visit with a PCP during the current year or the year prior

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Use appropriate billing codes as described above.
- Educate patients on the importance of having at least one ambulatory or preventive care visit during each calendar year.
- Contact patients on the opportunity list who have not had a preventive or ambulatory health visit.
- Make reminder calls to patients who have appointments to decrease no-show rates.
